The New College is a Government - Aided Muslim minority College affiliated to the University of Madras. It was founded by the Muslim Educational Association of Southern India (MEASI). Since its inception in 1951 with about 200 intermediate course students, The New College has rigorously upheld commitment to providing quality Higher Education to the deserving students, especially from weaker sections of the society. The college is currently run by a Managing Committee of the MEASI under the Chairmanship of H.H. Nawab Mohammed Abdul Ali Azimjah, *Prince of Arcot*.

On our beautiful campus on Peters Road, Royapettah, Chennai, about 6000 students pursue their intellectual passion through more than 35 academic programmes. The New college campus also houses three other institutions run by its parent body viz., MEASI Academy of Architecture, MEASI Institute of Management and MEASI Institute of Information Technology.

Although the college and its allied institutions were established to educationally empower students belonging to the Muslim community in Tamil Nadu, the college has students and teachers from different communities and almost all parts of India. We have a few students from abroad as well. There is a provision for nearly 500 students to reside on the College campus. The parent body of the college uses a major share of income every year to give scholarships to students from economically less privileged families.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a programme organized by the Ministry of Education and Youth Services affiliated to the Government of India to offer opportunities and training in service to the community and the nation for students with an aptitude. It is intended to involve the college students in a variety of social service and developmental activities concomitantly with the normal academic programme. The motto of the scheme is "Education through Community Service". Students of the first and second year Degree classes are eligible for admission. A total of 400 students will be enrolled in our college units which will be under the control of three Programme Officers.

The NSS aims to develop in its volunteers the following:

1. A spirit of selfless service to our people in distress, poverty and ignorance, irrespective of region, language, religion and caste.
2. A capacity to identify and study community problems, to plan and to carry out welfare projects as a team.
3. A willingness to share the benefits of modern higher education with our people who did not get this benefit.
4. A dignity for manual work and respect and concern for our rural masses and
5. A living faith in the unity of India and our great national heritage.

Four units of NSS function with 100 students per unit. Various developmental activities are conducted in the adopted villages annually, thereby creating permanent assets for the welfare of the needy.

The college provides training to students in N.C.C. under the infantry wing and armored squadron. Arrangements are made for training the air wing, naval wing, and artillery.

Enrollment of cadets is made soon after admission to the college. All items of N.C.C. kit and uniform issued free must be returned intact at the end of each year of training.

N.C.C. deposits must be paid in the college once and the receipts obtained should be handed over to the respective coy. commander.

Smart and capable cadets are entitled to selection for adventure courses, all India advance leadership camps, summer training camps of other states, training in the Himalayan mountaineering institute, republic day parade contingent at New Delhi, etc. Outstanding cadets are entitled to selection for going abroad under a youth exchange program.



HOSTEL



The Hostel Committee will consist of the Principal, the Deputy Warden and two Senior Members of the Staff nominated by the Principal. They will hold at least one meeting every month to pass the accounts, to formulate policies as regards maintenance of the discipline etc., The committee will be assisted by the resident superintendents, who shall be the member of the college staff.

The Hostel shall be under the direct control of the Principal of the college who is the ex-officio warden of the hostel. Subject to the approval of the warden, the Dy. warden shall make by-laws for the effective internal management of the hostel.

Students who want accommodation in the hostel should obtain the necessary application form from the hostel office and apply after getting admission in the college and enrolled therein. Students joining hostel shall pay the prescribed fees.

PLACEMENT CELL AND CAREER GUIDANCE CELL

The Career Guidance Cell at The New College functions under the direct control and directions of the Principal of the College. A team of Professors nominated by the Principal, work together to guide the students on Career opportunities

The objective of the cell is to identify the talents available among the students of this College and nurture and harness them further and offer guidance to choose a bright and right career

The activities of the cell include collecting the database of the students and compiling them for use when needed. The cell facilitates the students to improve their skills to face various competitive exams such as civil service exams conducted by UPSC and TNPSC. The Career Guidance Cell organizes seminars and meetings to encourage the students to plan their future. Above all, the main function of the cell is to invite reputed companies to the campus to conduct campus interviews and find suitable jobs for the skills available among the students

The cell also facilitates the economically weaker sections of the students of first and second year undergraduate courses to find suitable part time jobs to supplement the family income without affecting the academic pursuit
